Safety

Unpacking

Packaging material is not a toy

Dispose of plastic bags and other packaging material properly immediately after unpacking.

Children, persons with disabilities or animals cannot assess the risks posed by packaging material and may be injured or killed while playing.

Keep the instructions in a safe place

These instructions belong to the umbrella. Keep this manual for future reference, so that you or other persons can access the information on safety and operation. *Missing information can lead to accidents.*

Proper use

The umbrella is designed to guard against precipitation. Any other use, even in extreme weather situations, is not permitted. Use for other purposes may result in injuries.

Opening _____

Check for damage

Check the umbrella for damage before opening. If you notice any damage, do not open the umbrella.

À damaged umbrella can injure you when opening it.

Only proficient persons

Only allow proficient persons to open or close the umbrella.

Inexperienced persons, persons with disabilities, or small children can injure themselves or other persons when opening or closing.

Pay attention to your surroundings

Pay attention to the area around you when opening and closing the umbrella. You need enough free space around you when opening and closing the umbrella.

You, other persons or animals may be injured when the device is opened out.

Closing 4

Secure the umbrella with the closing strap

Secure the umbrella with the closing strap after closing. This prevents accidental opening of the umbrella.

An umbrella opening unexpectedly can cause injuries.

Storage 💻

Choose a safe place

Choose a safe place for storage that is not accessible to persons with disabilities or children.

Playing with the umbrella can cause injury to persons.

Keep the "Open and close" button clear.

Ensure that the button is not accidentally pressed permanently when in storage.

A button that is pressed permanently may cause the battery to overheat.

Disposal

Do not dismantle the umbrella

Do not dismantle the umbrella before disposal.

You may be injured on sharp edges or pointed parts.

Unpacking

After unpacking, please dispose of the packing material properly. Observe the regulations for disposal for your local area.

Protective cover

Closing strap

Take umbrella from the protective cover Open the closing strap



Do not reach into the ribs when opening or closing the umbrella. There is a risk of crushing injuries.



▶ Hold the umbrella away from you and press the "Open" button. The umbrella opens up.



You can close the umbrella by pressing the button.



- Hold the umbrella away from you and press the "Close" button. The umbrella closes.
- Secure the umbrella with the closing strap

Charging

The umbrella has a rechargeable battery. If the Open/ Close button is red, you have to charge the battery. Use the USB charging cable supplied for charging the battery.





Type A connector

Charging plug

The USB charging cable has a type A connector and a charging plug

• Put the charging plug in the charging socket of the umbrella

You can use a typical USB charger as a charger. The charger must meet the following requirements:

Output	5 V
Current	450 mAh

Connect type A connector to an appropriate charger. The LED on the handle of the umbrella lights up red during charging.

Notice:

When the battery is charged, the LED is green.

• After charging is completed remove the charging plug from the charging socket and close the charging socket with the cover.



You should keep the umbrella dry and in a safe place.

Tips

- Leave a wet umbrella open to dry.
- You can safely store the dry umbrella closed, with fastening strap and the protective cover.

Care The umbrella requires little care.

Tips

- You can use a damp cloth for the cover. Do not use any cleaning product, otherwise the cover will become permeable to water.
- A dry, soft cloth is suitable for the shaft and handle.

Technical specifications

The umbrella has a motor and batterv.



When the umbrella has served its time, you can dispose of it like a small electrical appliance. Find out about the regulations applicable to your local

area at the time of disposal.



Do not dispose of umbrella in household waste.

 You can put the umbrella into the collection for electrical and electronic equipment.
